Description

A rare set of six Wedgwood blue lustre plates designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones circa 1915 (pattern X8485). Powder-blue mottled ground with lavish hand-gilded decoration: birds, Japanese-inspired pines and landscapes, a rural village view; continuous gilt wave-and-scroll rims.

These plates were sold as functional tableware, yet their pristine condition shows they were never used. A rare case for Makeig-Jones' designs--typically decorative rather than utilitarian--and exceptionally preserved, with prestigious retailer provenance.

All six plates are double-marked -- Wedgwood and special retail order for James Powell & Sons (Whitefriars Glass

Works, London). Whitefriars were premier London glass and stained-glass makers who retailed Wedgwood in their showrooms and presented such ensembles at exhibitions of the period.
