Biography Robert Detheux, born in Brussels in 1932, established himself in the 1950s as a singular figure in the Belgian art scene, notably through his involvement in the surrealist and Dadaist movements. His works demonstrate his ability to blend poetry, subversion, and plastic invention. From the 1970s, he moved towards a lyrical abstraction, while retaining the influence of surrealism and Dadaism.
