Head to the right of Caroline Bonaparte represented in imitation of a Greek nymph with the legend in Greek letters: ΒΑΣΙΛΙΣΣΑ ΚΑΡΟΛΙΝΗ (Queen Caroline). She was the youngest sister of Napoleon I and the wife of Joachim Murat. Smooth edge without hallmark. Diameter: 23 mm. 6.59 g. TTB+RARE. Beautiful old collection patina.
