This pretty living room pedestal table from the beginning of the 19th century, in the Charles X style, tripod leg with an hexagonal shaft, entirely veneered in veined blond maple, with a pattern of regular dark foliage on the top surrounding a central five-pointed star in rosewood and ebony. The top is encircled with ebony fillets extending over the belt. The robust tripod base with a robust central body has six facets framed with ebony fillets, on the feet of the same opulent and functional, well-preserved. This pretty living room table has a lot of elegance and is very practical due to its size for a romantic dinner, or at the end of a sofa with an important lamp (its structure allows it), this pretty piece of furniture is very decorative due to its beautiful dress and its powerful and balanced proportion, furniture
