FONTAINEBLEAU, Last third of the 18th century. Very rare provenance for this type of object for this center of which this is the second observation of the last forty years. In very good condition. This object was used by shepherds and field workers, day laborers ... etc. There were several sizes, the number of which varies according to the production centers, from 4 to 6.
