signed "Pachini"

Italy, mid-late 20th century

Rectangular decorative plaque in polished flat glass, reverse-painted with enamel and metallic pigments to depict a stylized female profile with flowing green hair. The composition blends Art Deco revival elegance with mid-century fashion illustration influence, set against a richly textured ground of gold, bronze, crimson, and green tones.

Executed in the *sotto vetro* (reverse-painted) technique, where all details are applied to the back of the glass, then sealed and backed in a resin/fiber layer for protection. Signed vertically "Pachini" at the edge. Fitted with a hanging wire to the reverse for wall display.
