An installation is a three-dimensional work of art, often large-scale, which transforms a space into an immersive experience for the viewer. In this case, the work uses elements such as an artist's book, soil samples (which may evoke nature, terroir or matter), etc. Dimensions: 15.5 x 5.5 cm H: 22.5 cm François Bouillon was born in Limoges in 1944. A self-taught artist, his work is ethnological, mythological, symbolic and poetic, treated with a lot of humor. He uses materials of natural (earth, stone, fire) and organic (feathers, bones) origin, and plays with counting and contradictions. He practices drawing, photography and sculpture. works exploring the themes of memory and the ephemeral. ALAIN TANNER: Alain Tanner is a Swiss director and screenwriter, born in Geneva on December 6, 1929 and died on September 11, 2022. He was a major figure of the "new Swiss cinema" alongside Michel Soutter and Claude Goretta. He is known for his work in fiction, notably with films such as "Jonas, who will be 25 years old in the year 2000" and "In the White City". A director from Vaud, he is a major figure in Swiss cinema and his work is recognized well beyond Switzerland's borders.
