This deep shade, typical of the precious fabrics of the period, enhances an abundant plant decoration, where stylized flowers, foliage and flower baskets are elegantly intertwined, evoking the decorative richness of the Second Empire or refined country houses. Each curtain is adorned on one side with a gathered flounce, bringing an additional touch of refinement and movement to the ensemble. The overall condition is very good, the colors remain fresh and vibrant despite the age of the fabric, which testifies to its beautiful original quality. With generous dimensions - 303 cm high by 88
