Description

This antique Swedish two-part corner cabinet is a decorative and functional piece of furniture, typical of Scandinavian rural furniture from the late 18th or early 19th century. Designed to maximize the use of a corner, it consists of a lower and an upper part, each opening with a door decorated with hand-painted naive floral motifs. The cabinet is made of fir painted using the rechampi technique, a traditional decorative process consisting of applying a contrasting color to the moldings, hollows, and reliefs to emphasize the structure of the piece. Here, the rechampi is discreet and partially faded by time, which gives the whole an authentic patina with undeniable charm. The uprights with wide cut sides, the molded cornice, and the central niche carved with a star testify to the rustic and elegant
