Handcrafted quilt made using the traditional Kantha technique, originating from the Bengal region (India and Bangladesh). The piece features a central fabric with a red and white checkered pattern, enhanced by hand-stitched polychrome embroidery in cotton threads of blue, yellow, red, and black tones.

The Kantha technique, passed down through generations, involves layering recycled fabrics and joining them with decorative running stitches.

Traditionally, these items were made by women for domestic use or as ceremonial gifts. Origin: India or Bangladesh

Period: Mid-20th century

Condition: Good overall condition, with minor signs of wear consistent with age and original use.
