Coming from the second half of the 19th century, they demonstrate remarkable craftsmanship and a European fascination with the Orient at that time. Each of these dogs stands with presence on its legs, the silhouette is imposing without being overwhelming, exuding both solemnity and grace. The ancient patina of the bronze reveals nuances, ranging from deep brown to golden reflections, highlighting the work. These fau dogs - symbols of protection in China, where they traditionally guard the entrance to temples and palaces - here display a carefully guarded expression between vigilance and gentleness.
