## Description

A testament to exceptional craftsmanship, this solid mahogany console table, dating from the second half of the 19th century, embodies all the stylistic richness of the Napoleon III era. Made from a noble wood with a warm hue, it is topped with elegant glued Carrara marble, whose veined whiteness contrasts harmoniously with the depth of the mahogany. The front reveals a drawer hidden in the belt, cleverly integrated into the carved decoration. This is finely molded with scroll and flower motifs, evoking the eclectic and ornamental taste specific to this period. Each detail seems to want to tell a story, that of an era passionate about decorative arts. The front uprights, finely openworked, are also enriched with carved motifs, enhancing the lightness and sophistication of the whole. They extend
