

Monumental Pair Of Neoclassical Bronze And Marble Candelabras, After Carrier-belleuse

Description

Crafted with meticulous precision and artistry, these monumental candelabra emanate neoclassical grandeur. Each piece prominently features a full-length Classical female figure, masterfully sculpted from patinated bronze, embodying the spirit of ancient tales and timeless elegance. The beauty of her form is accentuated by intricately detailed draping robes, solidifying the piece's neoclassical essence. Rising from the figure's outstretched hands is a pristine marble sphere, encased within a radiant gilt bronze support, from which sprout thirteen delicately wrought light branches. These branches are adorned with scrolled leaf embellishments, epitomizing excellent craftsmanship. The central stem, bathed in gleaming ormolu, is ornamented with variations of bead-and-reel friezes at its

terminals, accompanied by leaf motifs enveloping the marble sphere. The sculptures are poised atop ormolu-mounted bases of veined red marble, culminating in majestic claw feet. The base's lower facade is beautified with ormolu escutcheons and a regal acanthus leaf band, while the upper section boasts ormolu flower festoons, dainty bows, and a leaf-and-dart patterned frieze, capturing the essence of the Romantic style. Intriguingly, while the central figure's design mirrors the genius of French sculptor Albert-Ernest Carrier-Belleuse (1824-1887), these candelabra distinguish themselves through their unparalleled craftsmanship, standing as a testament to artisanal dedication. Their imposing stature ensures they command attention, transforming any spacious room into a bastion of opulence and allure. Truly, a remarkable embodiment of artistic finesse and neoclassical romance.
