Rare Louis XIII table in gayak wood, a precious and dense wood, dating from the end of the 17th century or very early 18th century. This 17th century table, in solid wood, reflects all the refinement of antique Louis XIII furniture, with its turned baluster base and its H-shaped spacer an assembly typical of noble furniture of this period. The natural wood top, slightly patinated, opens with a drawer in the belt, carefully restored in the past, respecting the original structure. Each element - from the balanced proportions to the finesse of the turning - testifies to exceptional cabinetmaking know-how, characteristic of prestigious solid wood furniture. Thanks to its balanced dimensions, this baluster table with H-shaped spacer can be used as an antique console table in precious wood, an elegant side
