Description

This wool embroidery, known as 'woolie' or 'woolwork', was created by a British sailor around 1875. These works were traditionally made by sailors during long periods at sea as a pastime and souvenir of their naval service. These embroideries are particularly appreciated by collectors of maritime and folk art for their authentic character and their testimony to 19th-century maritime life. Enthusiasts of British naval history value these pieces for their detailed depiction of ships and patriotic symbols, such as the Union Jack flags seen in this work.
