Crafted in wood and sheathed in leather, it displays gilded edges, hot-stamped titles, and serial numbering reminiscent of prestigious French literary collections. The visible titles in French -- Holy Bible, Sermons of Father Cheminais, Treaty of the Armistice, Law - Modern Errors, and General Code of Copyright -- conjure an era of intellectual refinement and aristocratic taste. Presented as a set of antique volumes, the box embodies the discreet elegance of period libraries. The simulated spines are finely adorned with cold-stamped gilt motifs, echoing classical 18th-century bindings. A brass

hinge, perfectly preserved and subtly integrated, opens to reveal a concealed compartment -- a utilitarian function hidden behind a purely decorative façade.
