The base of the handle is decorated with a coat of arms. It is fully engraved with a corporate attribute (?) depicting a crowned heart of the Passion flanked by two rampant lions accompanied by a series of surnames and the commemorative date of a fiftieth anniversary, 1699. The lid bears an engraved mention: PETER KRÖGER, name of the owner of the tankard or of a corporate sworn guard. Hallmarking: 1°- of Johann Christian BEUTRICH received master in 1749, affixed twice 2°- city hallmark incompletely affixed Height: 21.6 cm. DRESDEN, Mid-18th century
