Brabant Revolution Commemorative Medal -
1789 Bronze, 34 mm
A historic bronze commemorative medal issued during the Brabant Revolution, marking the restoration of liberties and laws in the Duchy of Brabant at the end of 1789.
Obverse: Inscription within a laurel wreath: "RECUPERATIS LEGIBUS AC LIBERTATE SANCTA SOLENNI IURE IURANDO REPVBL." ("Having recovered the laws and liberty, sanctified by solemn oath of the Republic.")
Reverse: Inscription within a laurel wreath: "OMNIUM BRABANTIAE ORDINUM CONSENSU PRID. CAL. IANVAR. MDCCLXXXIX." ("By the consent of all the Estates of Brabant, on the day before the Kalends of January 1789" -> December 31, 1789.)
