shell-shaped carts on large wheels; fronts with a lion mask and rocaille leaf
ornament; sides with rocaille scrolls; interiors white. Sponged "earth" bases
are typical of late-19th-century Thuringia.
Painted in a Dresden-style pastel
palette with raised "pearl" gilding characteristic of
Kister.

Underglaze blue "KPM" above crossed strokes; impressed 1445-9; vent hole. Under Professor Reinhard

Möller (from 1877), Kister expanded modelling quality; in the 1890s the factory issued pairs and centrepieces (female dancers, dancing couples, historical figures) and lace figures after early Meissen prototypes. Related groups include carts, sledges and children with barrows in the same palette and raised gilding.
