This sumptuous gold leaf gilded wood mirror embodies the elegance of the Louis XV style, as it was revisited during the second half of the 19th century. Its beveled glass rests in a finely molded frame, enhanced by a pearl garland that emphasizes its nobility. On the sides, carved flower garlands gracefully descend, evoking Rococo refinement and the pronounced taste for natural ornaments. The large pediment immediately catches the eye: it is adorned with an imposing central shell, emblem of the Louis XV style, skillfully framed with acanthus leaves, a classic symbol of abundance and majesty. This large oval mirror is a true decorative work, capable of transforming a room and bringing a touch of splendor, worthy of bourgeois interiors or aristocratic salons of the 19th century.
