Alternatives Roberto Arioli / Gabbianelli: sculptural approach, playing with the volume of marble to create autonomous objects, often connoted "space age" or sculptural, around the 1960s. Angelo Mangiarotti / Knoll: formal rationalism, minimizing volume, and using marble as a refined utilitarian object, typical of
