Description

A rare and highly collectible Wedgwood Lustre bowl, with slightly worn pattern Z4831, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones circa 1915. The green lustre exterior, enriched with multicolored stainings producing a violet sheen, is decorated with finely gilded oriental animal motifs. The interior in soft green lustre is centered with a coiling dragon bearing a human face, flanked by stylized blue clouds.

Makeig-Jones was instrumental in reviving Wedgwood's profitability during the early 20th century, but she approached her work as more than commercial design. She
