These brilliant Wedgwood lustres came triumphantly to life, and the initial pattern number of the "First Ten Lustre Decorations", Z4823, saw the light of day in October 1914, appropriately enough almost exactly nine months after Daisy full Z4823 establishment as a staff designer! belongs to the formative group of Fairyland Lustre designs that sought to bring imaginative, jewel-toned decoration to an era overshadowed by the First World War. Its exterior is Dark Green Lustre, mottled with dark all-color stainings, the
