Charming 19th-century gouache depicting the city of Naples seen from the sea, with Castel Sant'Elmo prominently visible on the hill and Mount Vesuvius smoking in the background. In the foreground, animated boats with figures bring liveliness to the scene, a characteristic feature of Neapolitan gouache painting of the Grand Tour period. This type of view was highly appreciated by European travelers who visited Naples during the 19th century and brought back such works as refined souvenirs.
