Hippolyte Garneray (1787-1858) was a French painter, watercolorist, and engraver, primarily known for his seascapes and landscapes. He was active in the 19th century, in an artistic context influenced by Romanticism and the rise of picturesque landscapes. He worked on marine scenes, harbor views, but also more classical landscapes. He was part of a family of artists: his father, Jean-François Garneray, and his brothers were also painters. On display at the Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, at 97 rue de Courcelles, in the 17th arrondissement.
