In the tumult of the sea, this trunk was much more than a simple container: it was a true traveling companion, a silent witness to the maritime voyages of the 19th century, a camphor wood marine trunk made in India of the journeys of sailors and explorers. Camphor wood, an exotic wood prized for its natural properties of resistance and protection against insects, gave these trunks a robustness appreciated to face the sometimes perilous crossings. This trunk is reinforced with brass straps and corner reinforcements, ensuring increased solidity against the shocks of the journey. The authenticity of this piece is confirmed by its period lock, guaranteeing the security of its contents, and by its inlaid boat handle, typical of nautical accessories. Each side has bronze
