Pair of armchairs in carved and lacquered wood with a sloping back, the baluster armrests resting on two tapered front legs and saber-shaped back legs. In good condition of woodwork without and stable. They are upholstered with a beautiful Jouy canvas with river decor, in good condition.

Suspension with original bands. Stamped with H Jacob on each rear crosspiece. Bibio Henri Jacob (25/09/1753-02/12/1824) Received master on September 29, 1779. Established rue Bourbon-Villeneuve in Paris then rue de l'échiquier. Cousin Germain of Georges, he also excelled in the production of seats, always of high quality, particularly under the Directory. He supplied the Royal and then Imperial Courts. These works are preserved in the museums of the Louvre, decorative arts, etc. Work from the
