Designed in the early 1940s to furnish the Aarhus Town Hall in Denmark--a project led by renowned architects Arne Jacobsen and Erik Møller, who commissioned Hans J. Wegner to create the furniture--the Town Hall Chair is a historic piece of Danish design. Made from solid oak, the chairs have been reupholstered in cognac leather, faithful to the original upholstery, and the frames cleaned and waxed to revive their luster while preserving the patina. These versatile chairs will fit perfectly into any interior, whether it be an office, living room, or bedroom. Its clean lines, harmonious proportions, and exceptional comfort foreshadow the future success of Hans J. Wegner, who became one of the most acclaimed designers of the post-war period.
