Each chair has a full seat resting on a solid base, with turned and sculpted front legs, connected by a carefully crafted central baluster crosspiece. The straight and simple rear legs naturally extend the uprights of the backrest, asserting balance and robustness. The rectangular, openwork and molded backrest is distinguished by its elegant scalloped contours, which bring a refined note to the sobriety of the oak. The warm patina of the wood, acquired over time, highlights the nobility of the species and gives the whole an authenticity full of character. Combining solidity, comfort and timeless
