Description

Superb and delicate alabaster sculpture by Emilio Fiaschi, depicting a child lying on a cushion, wearing a large, richly detailed ruffled hat. The face, imbued with gentleness and vivacity, reveals all the sensitivity of this Florentine sculptor trained in the great Italian academic tradition. Alabaster, a material prized for its luminous transparencies and translucent effects, lends itself admirably here to Fiaschi's virtuosity. The light draperies, the lace of the hat, the suppleness of the cushion, and the finesse of the features testify to an extremely delicate execution. Through the subtle play of light on the stone, the child seems to come to life, giving the scene a poetic realism typical of the Belle Époque. Emilio Fiaschi (1858-1941) distinguished himself with his alabaster and
