Polychrome bronze with patina, brown, gilded, as well as a cold-painted part. Signed on the terrace Drouot as well as the inscription Etling in Paris for the foundry. French school. Source: 19th century bronze statues. On the terrace, we find a commemorative plaque which says: the board of directors Banque liégeoise and Crédit Général, liégeois réunis To Monsieur urbain Hurard 1904 under director 1929 Édouard Drouot (April 3, 1859 - May 22, 1945) was a French sculptor, renowned for his works in bronze and marble. He came from a prestigious education at the Beaux-Arts in Paris, where he was a student of Émile Thomas and Mathurin Moreau. A member of the Salon des artistes français, he was awarded an honorable mention in 1889 and a 3rd class
