Typical interior musician scene from 19th-century genre painting: an old musician, seated and playing the violin, surrounded by various musical instruments (violin, drum, tuba, mechanical organ, music stand). An intimate and nostalgic atmosphere, imbued with tenderness, very popular in the second half of the 19th century. Smooth and detailed brushstrokes, realistic style with a narrative taste. This type of scene is found in the work of 19th-century German, Austrian, Dutch and Belgian painters, who specialized in interiors or portraits of musicians. The theme of the old musician, sometimes perceived as a teacher, passionate amateur or bohemian, is a recurring motif in the Germanic and Flemish Biedermeier tradition.
