Covered earthenware pot with the coat of arms of the Marquise de Pompadour. This is a 19th century Samson production (mark K or X for Samson earthenware - and 2 letters reminiscent of the Olerys Laugier de Moustiers mark). The Marquise de Pompadour had ordered a service from Moustiers for the Hôtel d'Evreux (Elysée today). Lid and feet with tin rim. The handle has a small defect. H. Approximately 22 cm
