"Escholier" - figure of a 14th-century student, studying at one of the French academies. The young man, dressed in medieval fashion, wears a sword at his belt. He holds a huge book under his arm. Signature: E. Picault. Émile Picault (1833 - 1915) - French sculptor, student of Henri Royer. He created in an allegorical and patriotic spirit. He was often inspired by figures of French warriors or mythological heroes. He was often inspired by the Middle Ages, depicting the inhabitants and musicians of the time. In 1883, he received a distinction at the Paris Salon. France, 19th/20th century. Patinated bronze. Dimensions: 50 cm x 19 cm x 15 cm. Condition: The lantern in the left hand is missing.
