This refined model perfectly illustrates the meeting between the great tradition of French elegance and the geometric and refined lines specific to the vocabulary of the Art Deco period. Luc Lanel, a key figure in 20th-century design, particularly distinguished himself in the creation of silverware pieces for the prestigious ocean liner Normandie, a true floating palace and emblem of the Art Deco style, tragically destroyed by fire at Pier 88 in New York Harbor.
