Living room composed of a pair of bergères with gendarme hats, in lacquered wood and green rechampi, the bergères stamped PF JEAN for Paul-François Jean, carpenter in seats received master on October 5, 1784, practiced rue de fbgSaint Antoine, he made quality seats, and "luxury" seats with the help of the sculptors Joigny; Cresson Duclos and Mancien one of the two bergères bears the "rare" and mysterious mark: CJYM, we find it in second stamp with other carpenters in seats like Dupain, Forget, Carpentier or Mariette This stamp can be attributed to Claude Javoy master in 1779, or perhaps second possibility that of the mark of a sculptor ...? A three-seater Louis XVI period sofa, lacquered and reupholstered in green. This "beautiful" and classic set is covered in a
