RARE Trade Furniture Display cabinet "CARR'S & CO BISCUITS" dating from the end of the 19th century This furniture has 3 compartments, with a glass door for each opening upwards, once opened it is held by a hinge called compass (in brass) This furniture is made of wood (type blond mahogany, mango or other exotic wood used in England at the end of the 19th century) with a white marble top. It is surmounted by the recognizable inscription "CARR'S & CO BISCUITS", which directly links it to one of the oldest (created in 1831) and most prestigious companies in the sector still in operation today. This type of display cabinet was most often found in shops. It was used to present biscuits to consumers. The lockers were slanted and designed to hold packets of biscuits, but also to
