eight points, accompanied by two small pendants in the form of a halberd, or fleur-de-lis and four spandrels. The shades are fresh and the thick, soft pile is in perfect condition. The selvages are impeccable as well as the fringes having the original length. Knotted in Kanchipuram, Kanchi, one of the seven holy cities of India. It was the capital of the great Dravidian kingdoms. This city is located on the Palar River in the state of Tamil Nadu in India, about sixty-five kilometers from Madras. This rug is a beautiful decorative and comfortable piece. The decor is abundant and beautifully designed and the wool is of high quality. The decor comes from the Sarouh rugs, or Sarouk, the Ecbatana of Antiquity, knotted for the Persian Sarouk in a few villages near Sarouk in the agricultural region of Arak. European buying houses have had agencies there since the middle of the 19th century. Most of these rugs are nicknamed hamadan by the merchants, particularly the runner rugs knotted in this region. These Persian or Indo-Persian rugs remain very popular in the United States, whose decorators appreciate the heavy and important luxurious wool pieces.
