It features a body entirely in mahogany marquetry enhanced with a particularly fine gilt bronze decoration and a thick top in Caunes Minervois marble. It opens with a wide door and three drawers. It shows some signs of use such as very small surface nicks or scratches, and a small veneer chip (on the left side, visible in the photos), but we decided to leave the credenza intact, in its original and excellent condition, with the exception of a very gentle cleaning, as we did not want to alter the sublime cabinetwork.
