Thumb rest cut with very beautiful engraving representing a Flower framed by fleurons, the whole surmounted by the engraving "VIVE LES FLEURS". Hallmarks (on body and handle) for DIEPPE before 1775 (small Crowned D), Hallmarks of Maison Commune for DIEPPE 1771-72 (Crowned V) and Hallmarks (large and small works) of the Master Goldsmith Pierre LE CANU received in 1763. Normandy Wine Taste from the rare Dieppe office in good condition and remarkably hallmarked, small trace of rework at the level of the attachment of the annular grip, micro-scratches of use.
