Magnificent and important Dessert Flatware Set in Vermeil (Gold on Silver) composed of 18 Forks, 18 Spoons and 18 Knives with mother-of-pearl handles, making a total of 54 Pieces. Cutlery with decoration simulating cut leather, scrolls, fruits and fleurons. Minerva Hallmarks 1st Title (.950) and Hallmarks of Master Goldsmith Henri-Louis CHENAILLIER (Hallmark with the initials "HC", a rising sun above and a star below) received in 1839, and for some pieces from Emile PUIFORCAT (EP and penknife) who subsequently took up this model. The Knives have mother-of-pearl handles, ferrules and bases in Vermeil with foliage and Fleur-de-Lis decoration. The blades of the Knives are also in Vermeil (Gold on Silver) with the Minerva Hallmarks 1st Title (.950), Hallmarks of
