Rare large Rouen Wine Taste in solid silver from the 18th century, plain and swollen model, border engraved "B. HEUTTE". Thumb rest cut with very beautiful engraving representing a Harlequin holding his hat in one hand and holding a flask in the other, all topped with the engraving "ARLEQUIN" framed by flowers. Charge hallmarks (large Crowned B) and Discharge (fruits) for ROUEN 1781-89, Common House Hallmark for ROUEN 1784 (Crowned B) and Hallmarks (on body and grip) of the Master Goldsmith Mathieu Pierre Michel LAMOUREUX received in 1763.
