Each blade bears the 1st Title Hallmark (.950) called "Coq" and guarantee for PARIS 1809-19 and the Hallmark of the Master Goldsmith and specialty cutler Simon SALMON (Hallmark with the initials "SS" a penknife and a point on each side) received in 1807. Extremely rare Empire period knife set of very good quality in very good condition, presented in a box lined with anti-oxidant fabric, micro-scratches from use. For the informed collector ...
