optical art. This model is characterized by its cubic structure whose lid is decorated with a network of circular cavities. It is documented as having been produced by Diverse Ting (Malmö, Sweden), though some sources mention Denmark. Edition details may vary and require verification. Ballégeer Edition The smaller model is marked Ballégeer, probably produced in Belgium in the 1970s. It is smaller in size but follows the same geometric spirit, with a surface punctuated by circular cavities. The word Ballégeer appears on the reverse, though little documentation is available on the manufacturer, leaving this attribution to be confirmed.
