Belgian painter He studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Brussels from 1915 to 1922 with Émile Fabry, Herman Richir and Constant Montald. From 1925, he himself became a professor at the School of Arts and Crafts in Etterbeek. He painted figures, nudes, portraits, still lifes and landscapes. His style is figurative. He created a decorative panel for the pavilion of the province of Brabant at the Brussels World Fair in 1935 and the poster for the Grand Cortège historique de Bruxelles in 1930.
