Description

Bronze proof with brown patina, depicting a standing sheep "Vosges Sheep", by the sculptor Pierre-Jules Mene (1810-1879) . The "Vosges Sheep Standing" is one of the two sculptures sent by P.J Mene to the Salon of 1865 . It represents a return of the artist to the series of"Pastures" . The oldest proofs are dated "1864", the year of creation of the work."The Vosges Sheep Lying Down" was created the following year in 1865. Signature of the sculptor "P.J.MÊNE", followed by the date "1864" in hollow on the naturalistic terrace, richly chiseled, enriched with a profile. Rare antique edition sculpture, period second half of the 19th century. Perfect state of preservation . Dimensions: 20.9 cm x 22.8 cm x 9.8 cm Pierre

is a French sculptor, born March 25, 1810 in Paris, city where he died on May 20 1879. He is considered to be one of the main representatives of animal sculpture in the 19th century .Pierre -Jules Mene produced many animal sculptures, particularly in vogue under the Second Empire, like Antoine-Louis Barye, Auguste Caïn, Pierre Louis Rouillard and , later , François Pompon .P.J Mene specialized in small bronzes, and did not produce work for public statuary .His animal subjects have enjoyed great popular success .Exclusive publisher of his works, the perfection of his productions is widely recognized .He reveals himself, with Antoine-Louis Barye, as the one whose success has been the most constant , and this over the longest period .Pierre - Jules Mene appears to be one of the best wax practitioners of his time.
