Louis XV period wardrobe in marquetry, elm and walnut made by Master Antoine Sertelon in 1773 this cabinetmaking jewel was born in the Charolais between Poule and Matourelle is inspired by Bressane while dressing itself with moldings specific to furniture from the south of Saone and Loire its history is partially noted on a parchment sheet found in the furniture it is very beautiful and elegant, of good quality, delicately carved and marquetry the cornice is "gendarme hat" the whole rests on arched feet with scrolls h244 x 156 x 72 cm
