With his wife Afra Bianchin (1937-2011) he started one of the most successful and well-known professional studios; together they signed many innovative projects on the industrial design scene. Numerous publications have been dedicated to their work and various projects created by them are exhibited in major museums around the world. The Italian furniture giant Cassina, originally Amedeo Cassina, was founded by brothers Cesare
