Japan, mid-Edo period (1603-1868). Stag-antler netsuke depicting a small porter squeezed between two bundles. Himotoshi drilled through one rear lobe; the porous core of the antler is visible at the tip. A playful trompe-l'oeil with a discreet erotic undertone, characteristic of Edo-period taste. Condition: honey patina, minor wear; fine material lines inherent to antler (stable). Size: H 7 cm; W 4 cm; D 2.7 cm.

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
