Bronze proof with brown patina , representing a dog trainer , by the sculptor Vincent Desire Faure De Brousse (1843-1908) . Vincent Desire Faure De Brousse , is a French sculptor , born in Paris , in 1843 . Student of Jules Salmson , he participated from 1876 to 1883 , in the Salon of Paris . The artist is renowned for his figurative sculptures influenced by the Florentine Renaissance . The dog trainer is represented during her show , she is dressed in her stage costume and holds a hoop , through which she makes the dog jump during her number . Signature of the sculptor on the richly chiseled terrace , representing a stage carpet . Sculpture of old edition , on the theme of the Circus , period second part of the XIXth century . Very good condition of conservation and patina (slight old
